Testing Protocol Adopted by MEC 3/11/2021

- 1. ENT cases, EGDs and pediatric mask inductions will still require Preop Covid testing.
- 2. Cases longer than 3 hours and/or patients that are considered higher risk of DVT (ie history of PE or DVT) will still require testing.
- 3. Testing will not be required for all other General or MAC anesthetics.
- 4. Patients who had an asymptomatic or minimally symptomatic Covid infection may undergo surgery at PSC, 21 days after PCR confirmation of Covid infection or the onset of symptoms, whichever is longer. Patients must be without fever or symptoms for at least 48 hours prior to surgery. This subset of patients will not require testing, except for ENT, EGDs and pediatric mask inductions, until 3 months after onset of symptoms or first positive Covid test.
- 5. Additional patients may be required to undergo Covid testing at the discretion of the anesthesiologist.
- 6. The policies will be reviewed frequently by the PSC MEC and adjusted as needed for changes in local Covid infection rates and perceived risk from Covid variants.

7. Any patients who are fully vaccinated (i.e., ≥2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine no longer require testing.

Post Covid Patient Rescheduling

- Patients may be scheduled or rescheduled <u>14 days</u> after a positive COVID test or the onset of symptoms, whichever is earlier. These patients must be asymptomatic at the time of surgery and were not hospitalized for COVID (or receive COVID specific treatment (ie antibodies, plasma, supplemental Oxygen)).
- Surgeries longer than 3 hours will continue to be held for 21 days post COVID.
- All other current COVID testing and vaccination requirements will remain in effect.

From 175 North: Exit 1285 East / Toward Greenville/Augusta

Take exit #26 Glenridge Connector – turn left on Glenridge and right on Hammond Drive, turn left on Peachtree Dunwoody Road, make first right into Perimeter Town Center, stay straight (no turns) Building B will be on right side.

From 185 North: Exit 285 West / Toward Chattanooga/Birmingham

Take exit # 28 Peachtree Dunwoody Road, turn right, go past Hammond Drive and make first right into Perimeter Town Center, stay straight (no turns) Building B will be on right side.

From I20 East: Exit 285 North toward Greenville/Chattanooga

From 175 South: Exit 1285 East toward Augusta/Greenville

Take exit # 28 Peachtree Dunwoody Road – turn right, go through light at Hammond Drive then make first right into Perimeter Town Center, stay straight (no turns) Building B will be on right side.

From 185 South: Exit 1285 North toward Birmingham/Chattanooga

Take exit #26 Glenridge connector turn left on Glenridge – right on Hammond Drive, turn left on Peachtree Dunwoody make first right into Perimeter Town Center, stay straight (no turns) Building B will be on right side.




